



Clothing Rules for Pack Visits

To make this event a pleasant experience for everyone, we ask you to adhere to the following points:

Clothing:

- No fluffy jackets (e.g. down jackets) or gloves
- Scarves should be hidden under the jacket
- No ribbons or tufts (e.g. on the hood)
- No skirts, dresses or short trousers
- No wool, leather or fur, even if it is artificial

Good to wear:

- Closed, robust shoes
- Jeans or trousers made from fabric
- Rain or outdoor jackets and jackets made out of cotton

All the rules concern the outer layer of clothing. If you are wearing a woolen pullover underneath which does not show during the pack visit, it is no problem.

Other advice:

- If you have long hair, please tie it together. If your hair is very long, please make a knot.
- Please do not wear a jacket or trousers that usually contain dog food.
